

What is Advocacy?

Advocacy is taking action to help you say what you want, secure your rights, represent your interests and obtain services you need.

Advocates and advocacy schemes work in partnership with the people they support and take their side.

Advocacy promotes social inclusion, equality and social justice.

Our Advocacy Services

Disability Can Do provides free and independent advocacy support services to disabled adults and their carers living within the Caerphilly County Borough. We can assist you with both short and long term issues via our professional advocate or through our volunteer led Citizen Advocacy scheme.

What we offer:

- A confidential one to one partnership with a trained advocate.
- Someone to listen to you and support you in exercising your rights, choices and interests.
- Someone to gather and present the information you need to make informed choices.
 - Someone to ensure that your views and needs are heard, respected and acted upon.
- Non-instructed advocacy to individuals with limited capacity.
 - A weekly in-patient advocacy service for individuals admitted to Ysbty Ystrad Fawr.

Who we can help:

- Disabled adults within the Caerphilly County Borough.
- Carers within the Caerphilly County Borough.

The Advocacy team operates an open referral service which is accessible to both members of the public and professionals. Please see overleaf for contact details.

Disability Can Do can also offer support with other issues such as benefits or housing.
